I, Alexander J. Petale, Esq., for Wrongs Without Wremedies, LLC, object to the paternity testing on three grounds.:


First, there is no established chain of custody for the DNA sample, allegedly taken from the deceased child prior to the time the body was allegedly interred.

Second, it's highly irregular that a DNA sample would be taken by a government entity of a six-year-old child in the absence of any legal proceeding, e.g., a paternity suit or a child victim of a crime, (there was no criminal prosecution in this case) which would have required the taking of a DNA sample prior to the time the child's body was allegedly interred.

Third, the issue of paternity of the child is not a subject of the book *Nobody Died at Sandy Hook* and is irrelevant to the defamation claim.
